

Names of Jesus

There are hundreds of names, titles, and descriptions of Jesus in the Bible, from Genesis to The Revelation. These are but representative examples; may they bring joy to your prayers of worship.

Light of the World: When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world . Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

Bread of Life: Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life . He who comes to me will never go hungry...." (John 6:35)

The Gate, the Door: Jesus said again, "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep. ...I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved." (John 10:7, 9)

The Good Shepherd: "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." (John 10:11)

Son of God: If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in him and he in God. (1 John 4:15)

Son of Man: "...just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Matthew 20:28)

Teacher: "And do not call anyone on earth 'father,' for you have one Father, and he is in heaven. Nor are you to be called 'teacher,' for you have one Teacher, the Christ." (Matthew 23:9-10)

Savior: And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world. (1 John 4:14)

The Way, the Truth, the Life: Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

Redeemer: Christ redeemed us.... in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles...so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit." (Galatians 3:13, 14)

The Resurrection and the Life: Jesus said..."I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25-26)

The true Vine: "I [Jesus] am the true vine , and my Father is the gardener. ...I am the vine; you are the branches." (John 15:1, 5)

Alpha and Omega: "Behold, I [Jesus] am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done. I am the Alpha and the Omega...." (Revelation 22:12-13)

Beginning and the End: Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

Radiance of God's Glory: The Son is the radiance of God's glory.... (Hebrews 1:3)

Author of Our Faith: ...let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith.... (Hebrews 12:1-2, NKJV)

The exact representation of the Father: The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. (Hebrews 1:3)

The head of the body, the church: And he is the head of the body, the church... (Colossians 1:18)

Prince of Peace: For to us a child is born, to us a son is given.... And he will be called ...Prince of Peace....
(Isaiah 9:6)

Everlasting Father: For to us a child is born, to us a son is given.... And he will be called ...Everlasting Father...
(Isaiah 9:6)

Wonderful Counselor: For to us a child is born, to us a son is given.... And he will be called Wonderful
Counselor.... (Isaiah 9:6)

Mighty God: For to us a child is born, to us a son is given.... And he will be called ...Mighty God.... (Isaiah 9:6)

King eternal, immortal, invisible: Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and
glory for ever and ever. (1 Timothy 1:17)

Wisdom of God and the power of God: ...but to those whom God has called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ
the power of God and the wisdom of God. (1 Corinthians 1:24)

The Great Light that shines on those who walk in darkness: The people walking in darkness have seen a
great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned. (Isaiah 9:2)

Our resting place: "My people have been lost sheep; their shepherds have led them astray and caused them to
roam on the mountains. They wandered over mountain and hill and forgot their own resting place." (Jeremiah 50:6)

Commander of the army of the LORD: Now when Joshua was near Jericho, he looked up and saw a man
standing in front of him with a drawn sword in his hand. "...as commander of the army of the LORD I have now
come." (Joshua 5:13-14)

Lord of lords and King of kings: They will make war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will overcome them be-
cause he is Lord of lords and King of kings... (Revelation 17:14)

The faithful and true: I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called
Faithful and True. (Revelation 19:11)

Our Lord and our God: Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!" (John 20:28)

Lion of the Tribe of Judah: Then one of the elders said to me [John], "Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of
Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals." (Revelation 5:5)

Our Cornerstone: ...you are... fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, built on the
foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. (Ephesians 2:19-20)

Word of God: He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God. (Revelation 19:13)

Lord of Peace: Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times and in every way. (2 Thessalonians
3:16)

Lord of Glory: None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the
Lord of glory. (1 Corinthians 2:8)

Atoning Sacrifice: He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole
world. (1 John 2:1-2)

Lamb of God: When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, "Look, the Lamb of God!" (John 1:36)

Bright Morning Star: “I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star.” (Revelation 22:16)

The Righteous One: But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense-Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. (1 John 2:1)

The True God: And we are in him who is true-even in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life. (1 John 5:20)

Great Shepherd of the sheep: ...our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep... (Hebrews 13:20)

Lord of the Sabbath: “For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath.” (Matthew 12:8)

Hope of Glory: To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. (Colossians 1:27)

The Image of the Invisible God: He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. (Colossians 1:15)

Our Comforter: Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, 4 who comforts us in all our troubles.... (2 Corinthians 1:3-4)

Our Defender: ...for their Defender is strong; he will take up their case against you. (Proverbs 23:11)

Our Deliverer: He is my loving God and my fortress, my stronghold and my deliverer.... (Psalm 144:2)

Our Fortress: But the LORD has become my fortress.... (Psalm 94:22)

Our Guide: For this God is our God for ever and ever; he will be our guide even to the end. (Psalm 48:14)

Our Healer: “...for I am the LORD, who heals you.” (Exodus 15:26)

God of Hope: May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:13)

Our King: The LORD is King for ever and ever.... (Psalm 10:16)

Our Protector: You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance. (Psalm 32:7)

Our Provider: So Abraham called that place The LORD Will Provide. (Genesis 22:14)

Our Refuge: Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge. (Psalm 46:1)

Our Rock: To you I call, O LORD my Rock.... (Psalm 28:1)

Our Shield: The LORD is a shield for all who take refuge in him. (Psalm 18:30)

Our Strong Tower: The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe. (Proverbs 18:10)

Our Sure Foundation: "See, I lay a stone in Zion...a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation...." (Isaiah 28:16)

Creator: The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. (Isaiah 40:28)

Lifter of our heads: But you are a shield around me, O LORD; you bestow glory on me and lift up my head. (Psalm 3:3)
